They told us that the best way to have a lasting impact on children and families is to build a preschool. A place where children could not only receive an education, but also be fed two healthy meals per day, and have a safe place to be while their parents were out working. So we built them one, and it has been our main focus of ministry since.

This year several of us on the board were able to make the trip to Somoto. It had been several years since we were last there. We were blessed to see that with the strong leadership of Marta and Candida, the preschool was thriving and doing well. A big thank you to these two ladies, our teachers and volunteers, and to those of you who have generously supported this ministry.
