Rev's Revelations

You know the light bulb jokes?

How many psychiatrists does it take to change a light bulb? (Only one, but the bulb has got to really want to change.)

How many actors does it take to change a lightbulb? (Only one, they don't like to share the spotlight.)

How many magicians does it take to change a lightbulb? (Depends on what you want to change it into.)

And, of course,

How many Lutherans does it take to change a lightbulb? (None. Lutherans hate change.)

We all get the joke—some of us even laugh —because we've been in the meetings where one member wants to change the color of the sanctuary carpet to a dark wine color (which would hide wine spills) while another refuses to accept that the old, heinous, bright red carpet with wine stains needs to be replaced at all. Some of us cringe though, too, because we've been that person who instantly has a sense of dread when presented with the latest change whether it's carpet or liturgy or staff or the lights.

In the six years I've been at Bethlehem, I've seen all of those changes—at least once and some very recent. As stressful as change can be, change is natural. And, we believe that change occurs by God's design. Early in the biblical narrative, just after the flood, the LORD promises to Noah,

"As long as the earth endures, seedtime and harvest, cold and heat. summer and winter, day and night shall not cease." - Genesis 8:22

The Star

The psalmist recognizes,

"You [God] have made the moon to mark the seasons;

the sun knows its time for setting."—Psalm 4:19

And the teacher in Ecclesiastes opens our minds to consider that like the seasons change, so the rest of life changes, too, "For everything there is a season, a time for every matter under heaven." Sometimes we want to hear about God's steadfastness. We want to think that God is allpowerful and unchanging. But sometimes we need to hear that God, while faithful and steadfast, created change. We need to be reminded that God's world has been changing since the beginning of time. We need to be reminded that life is a constant evolution. We need to be reminded that change, though sometimes scary, is a sign of God's faithfulness to Noah and to us.

Between now and our next newsletter, seasons will change again. Summer to Fall. We will begin Sunday School and Confirmation. Adult Forum, Naomi Circle, Lutheran Men in Mission will meet again. We will see that some people have come and some have gone. We will notice change. When we do, may we look for God's handiwork in it. May we be rooted in good memories of the past, may we make space for new growth around us now. May we appreciate the people and ideas which have come before us. May we welcome the people and ideas with which we are blessed today. And may we trust as day becomes night and summer becomes winter, that we are also always becoming. We are always changing. And may our changing be a sign of God's faithfulness to all creation.


Congregational Potluck
