Rev's Revelations

Rev's Revelations Feb-Apr 2026

Tell me something good.

Think of something good (and real) and tell me. Text me, email me. Write a postcard. Set a reminder in your phone to tell me Sunday morning...

...How long did it take you to think of something good? Are you still thinking about it? Did you give up? No judgment if you did. I get it. As a preacher, it is my job to proclaim good news--at least on Sunday mornings and at weddings and funerals. Every single week, I sift through bible stories, news reports, recent events, historical events, artwork, social changes, politics, and the rest of life, too, hoping that something good shakes out. Sometimes it's really hard. Sometimes, it's not until Sunday morning comes around that I actually hear good news. Then, I might hear it in a hymn, during the children's sermon, or finally in the joyful "thanks be to God and weeee will" someone decides to add at the end of service. Sometimes, you have to tell me something good.

And, that is why I am delighted to share our Lenten theme for this year: Tell me something good.

The writers from A Sanctified Art explain:

"Lent was originally a season for new converts to learn and prepare for their baptism on Easter. During that time, they would study what was central to Christianity. As we crafted this series, we studied what was central to Jesus' life and ministry: radical welcome, love for neighbor, care for the vulnerable, nourishment for the hungry, nonviolence in the face of injustice...Following Jesus leads to a richer, more expansive life, but it's not necessarily comfortable. Jesus' ministry can be described as 'radical' which comes from the Latin word 'radicalis,' meaning 'root' or 'ground.' Therefore, the good news should bring us back to our roots. Emulating Jesus and embodying his teachings should ground us in who God created us to be. Can we be 'good news' people in a world too often burdened by bad news?"

I think we can be--I think we are. Rooting ourselves in faith--not always in the same practices and traditions--but always in the spirit of welcome, love, and care that we learn from Jesus. At the very least, we can practice being 'good news people' this season--on Sundays at 8 and 10:15 am, on Wednesdays starting Feb 18 at 7 pm, through Holy Week and into the Easter season.

Treasurer Update

Treasurer's Update

Church finances are always a bit tricky. We seem to always struggle with getting a balance. For instance, the month of January looks to be about \$4,000 below in giving than our monthly budget predicts. January is also when we find out actual increases in costs from many vendors, thankfully, some do give us updates at the end of the year. We will do the best we can at updating everyone each month.

Please watch for a write-up to come out shortly regarding the Heritage Fund. This is a series of investment funds, formed by Congregational Resolution, in 2004. The purpose of the funds is to create "legacy funding" for various aspects of Bethlehem. Currently, we have two active funds, the Education Fund and the Worship Fund. In short, these funds were designed to pay for long term, non-budget items. As an example, the Education Fund uses the yearly gains to give scholarships to members who are in higher education. Several other funds, such as a property fund, were built into the resolution which have not been started yet. More on all of this soon.


A Day in a Year at BLC

October Sunday



“A Day in a Year at BLC” is a calendar fund drive that began May 1, 2025. The idea behind the drive was for everyone to choose a date/day and donate that amount of money to Bethlehem to be used to fill in the “gaps” we are having in our budget. I began representing you on Council in Stewardship Ministry in January. It wasn’t long after that I began to struggle with “surprise” expenses, such as the water heater failing, additional funding needed for VBS due to increased enrollment, and mechanical repairs required for Josephine. As a Council, we had to take funds from ministry budgets to pay for these costs. Council can now use the money from the calendar fund drive to pay for “surprise” expenses not covered in our budget.

So, how are we doing with the calendar fund drive? Thanks to you, after 4 months, \$13,717.00 has been raised. Many of you have chosen multiple days. If all the days are taken by May 1, 2026, a total of \$66,795 will have been raised. All of us doing “a little adds up to a lot”. Pick a day that works for you financially. The calendar has May 1 available (day 1 for \$1) and the highest number on the calendar is April 29th (day 364 for \$364).

What good, good news.


